III.閱讀測驗 (36~40 題，共 5 題)

The Marketing Information Center of the Information Industry Institute recently announced that sales of PCs in the domestic and overseas markets combined during the first quarter of 1992 jumped 15 percent, compared with the same period of last year. At the same time, the total sales value went up by 23.5 percent. From January until the end of March, the total amount of locally made PCs sold both here and abroad was about 619,000 units. Of the 619,000 units sold, portables accounted for 22.3 percent and tabletop models for 77.7

percent of the total. Many local PC producers agree that, although orders for the first quarter continued to expend, problems created by intense international competition and the sliding of prices of related computer parts have brought great pressure on the ROC computer business. North America absorbed the largest portion of ROC personal computer exports during the first quarter, taking 42 percent of the total value, while Western Europe took 37 percent.
