III. 閱讀測驗 (36~40 題, 共 5 題)

Many people do not like airplane food. They complaint that food tastes different on an airplane. Do you know it is because your taste changes while you are in the air? Studies show that dryness and low pressure in the airplane cabins will affect your sense of smell. It is said the **humidity** in the cabins are drier than most deserts. Other factors, such as the noise coming from the engine and the materials of the cutlery, will also influence our taste buds. Moreover, food is reheated rather than cooked fresh. It also changes the taste of food.

In an environment like this, your taste and smell start to become less sensitive. Sweet and salty senses are affected the most. However, other flavors such as sour, bitter and spicy are almost unaffected. For instance, Thai or Korean curry mostly remain the same taste as they do on the ground. Interestingly, tomato juice is usually considered to taste better on planes than on the ground. What can airline chefs do to solve the problems? They need to modify every **recipe** to make in-flight food taste better. For example, they usually add more salt and more natural intense flavors. Other technology is also applied to improve our taste buds. *British Airlines*, for instance, introduces soundtracks to match the taste of the food using noise-cancelling headphones. It is hoped that all those efforts could make in-flight meals taste more delicious.
